

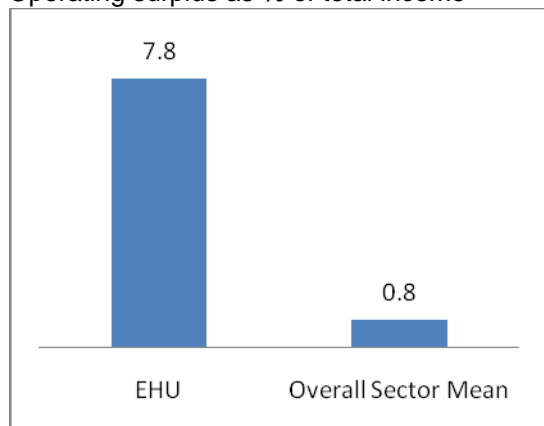
## Edge Hill University: Facts, Context and Comparisons

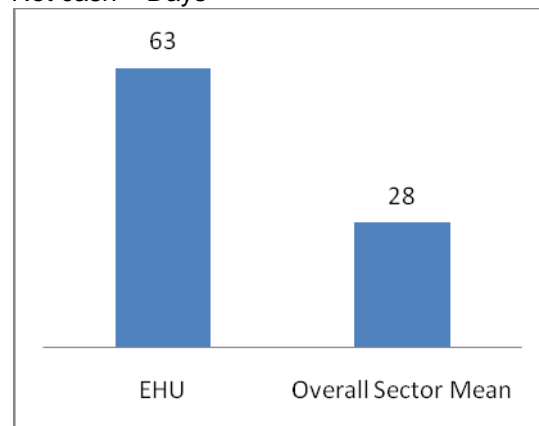
### Finance

Figures based on the most recent published national information (2009 Financial results and forecasts, published by HEFCE) 09-10 forecast

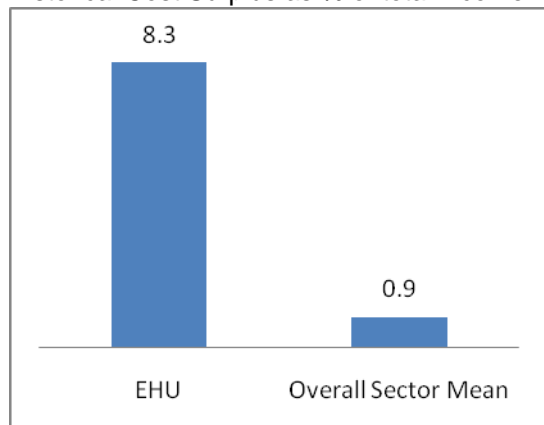
Operating surplus as % of total income



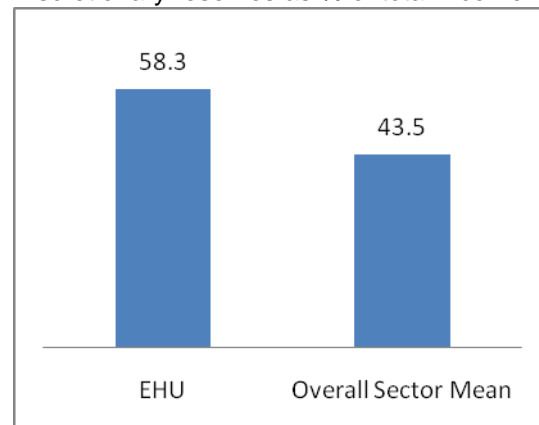
Net cash – Days

Discretionary reserves as % of total income



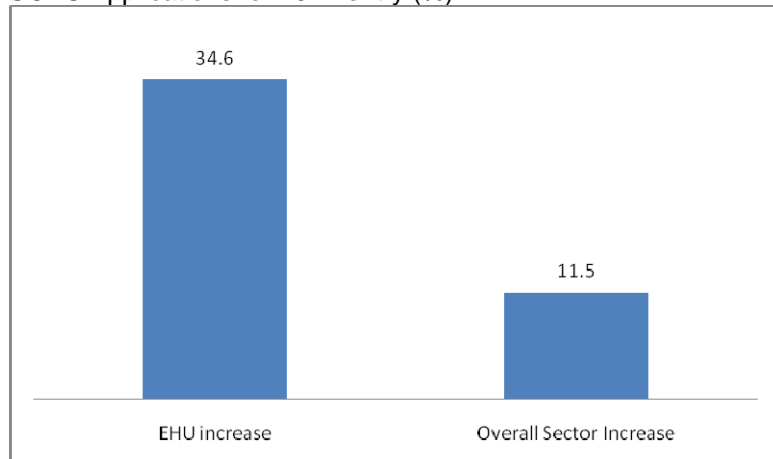
Based on published accounts for 2008/9, Edge Hill University has the largest surplus as a percentage of income of all North West universities. For Edge Hill this figure is 7.8% while others range from -16.4% to 6%.

The audited actual financial out-turn for 2009/10 was a historic cost surplus of £10.633m.

Edge Hill continues to invest in student facilities, with the £13.5 Hub building on target for 2011 opening.
