2018/19 POSTGRADUATE TAUGHT AND RESEARCH: ALUMNI FEE REMISSION SCHEME

If you are an Edge Hill graduate, ERASMUS+ or Study Abroad student you could benefit from a reduction in tuition fees when enrolling onto an eligible full-time or part-time postgraduate programme at the University for the first time during 2018/19.

The offer is intended to be as inclusive as possible and is open to all students who graduated within the last three years. This means that for academic year 2018/19 entry, students must have graduated from July 2015 onwards:

Edge Hill University graduates

- with Home, EU and Overseas resident status;
- holding an undergraduate award at Level five for example, Foundation Degree, BA, BSc or LLB, Professional Graduate Certificate in Education (up to Level six but not postgraduate), or a Graduate Diploma*;

• in receipt of an internal Faculty bursary towards postgraduate tuition fees. ERASMUS+ students

with EU resident status.

- Study Abroad students
 - who have studied at least one semester with Edge Hill University at undergraduate level.

All students must

- have responsibility for payment of their own tuition fees (ie no sponsor) (Receipt of a
 postgraduate loan via the Postgraduate Master's Loan Scheme will still entitle you to
 this benefit);
- be enrolled onto an Edge Hill University Postgraduate Certificate, Diploma, Masters or Research programme** either full or part-time, commencing in 2018/19;
- be studying a minimum of 60 credits a year (with the exception of PGCert SpLD Dyslexia);
- have no outstanding debt with the University.

Students will receive a 50% fee reduction for MRes provision and 20% fee reduction for all other eligible postgraduate programmes. The fee reduction applies for the full duration of the programme, excluding any repeat years.

Students will only be entitled to this remission for registration on one postgraduate programme only and no further discounts will be offered. If a sponsorship agreement is sought for payment of fees at any point during the programme the benefit will cease.
