Entry requirements & English Language

- First year of study completed
- Good standing with home institution
- Full and complete application and supporting documents
- Minimum GPA 2.75 (or country equivalent)
- For Full year Study Visa students: IELTS: 5.5 (no individual element below 5.5) or other acceptable English tests (*found on <https://www.edgehill.ac.uk/departments/support/international/english-language-requirements/>*)
- For **1 semester students**: must be able to study fully in English and have already studied at university level in English

**The Study Abroad programme is taught fully in English.*

Additional Information

Accommodation

- On campus accommodation is not guaranteed for Erasmus students – if we have availability, you will be contacted by our Accommodation Team to apply but you may need to look for private accommodation.
- Accommodation for a semester only can be difficult to obtain, please leave plenty of time to arrange accommodation.

Visa Requirements

An **ETA (Electronic Travel Authorisation)** is required prior to travel for all students studying for 6 months or less. Please check if you are eligible for an ETA here - <https://www.gov.uk/guidance/apply-for-an-electronic-travel-authorisation-eta>

A **Standard Visitor Visa** rather than an ETA is required for some nationalities and needs to be applied for this prior to arrival. Please check here - <https://www.gov.uk/check-uk-visa>

A **Study Visa** is required for students who will study at Edge Hill University for a full academic year, *as part of your offer email you will be sent a link to CAS Shield as you will need to be issued with a CAS (Confirmation of Acceptance of Studies) in order to apply for your visa.*
