Choosing a course:

- Do you offer the course I'm interested in studying?
- What grades/UCAS points do I need?
- Do I need any specific work experience?
- What modules can I choose from?
- Are there placement opportunities?
- What kind of assessments are on the course?
- What career prospects are there?

Choosing a University:

- Where is it located? Is it a campus-based or city-based university?
- Find out how far the university is from your home by public transport or car.
- What is the choice of accommodation?
- What student support is available?
- What are the facilities like?
- Why should I choose your university over others?

Choosing an apprenticeship/job:


- What opportunities do you currently have available?


Campus map
