

2019/20 HOME/EU¹ TUITION FEE LIABILITY PROCEDURE

In the event of withdrawal, interruption or restart of studies, all scheduled bursary and scholarship payments will cease with immediate effect. The table below details the fee liability, dependent upon last date of attendance/engagement, as outlined in the University's Withdrawal Procedures².

Tuition fee liability will be calculated at the approved rate for the registered mode of study.

Full time Foundation Year, undergraduate (including transfer to part-time), PGCE, MSc Nursing, MSc Midwifery.

Attendance in the Winter Term	100% of full tuition fee

July to August start

Within the first two weeks of the academic year	Nil fee

From week four of the third term	Full tuition fee

Faculty of Health & Social Care & Medicine Professional Learning

Up to 14 days from the start of a module	Nil fee
From day 15 of the start of a module	Full tuition fee

Master of Surgery (MCh) and Master of Medicines (MMed)⁴

When the offer of a job linked to an MCh or MMed Programme is made, students have a period of **2 weeks** to confirm their acceptance of both. If this conditional job offer is withdrawn for any reason, no fee will be charged.

From date of acceptance of job/place on programme until the last day of month three	50% of full tuition fee
From the start of month four	100% of full tuition fee

Attendance from re-enrolment at the start of Year Three	100% of tuition fee for Year Three

Full and Part Time MRes, MPhil, PhD and Professional Doctorate programmes

Exceptional arrangements for Interruption of studies

The annual tuition fee will be reduced by the daily rate for the number of days of interruption, verified by the Graduate Board of Studies. For 2019.20 the academic calendar is 365 days.

Separate arrangements apply for interruption of study during the formal writing-up period. See Research Degree Writing-up & Assessment Fees.

Part Enrolled

For students who have had a period of part enrolment, registration will be taken from the point at which enrolment on programme was undertaken.
