

Student Services – Money Advice Postgraduate Funding for current EHU students and Alumni

Eligibility for postgraduate fee remission

- If you are an Edge Hill graduate, former ERASMUS+ or Study Abroad student you could benefit from a tuition fee reduction when enrolling onto an eligible full-time or part-time postgraduate programme (excluding PGCE) for the first time during 2021/20.
- The offer is intended to be as inclusive as possible and is open to all students who graduated within the last three years. This means that for academic year 2021/22 you must have graduated from July 2018 onwards.



Criteria:

Edge Hill University graduates:

- With Home, EU and Overseas resident status;
- Holding an undergraduate award at level five, for example; Foundation Degree or at level six, for example; BA, BSc or LLB, Professional Graduate Certificate in Education, or a Graduate Diploma*

*Excludes Exit Awards

Former ERASMUS+ students:

• With EU resident status.

Former Study Abroad students:

• Who have studied at least one semester with Edge Hill University at undergraduate level.



What will I be entitled to?

For study on our qualifying Postgraduate Taught and Research programmes:

- 50% tuition fee discount for 2020/21 finalists, graduating in summer 2021
- 20% tuition fee discount for 2018/19 and 2019/20 finalists with 50% discount for MRes study

Fee discount conditions:

- The fee reduction applies for the full duration of the programme, excluding repeat years.
- This benefit is only offered once per programme, with the exception of students progressing to PhD study within three academic years of completing postgraduate taught or research awards; where remission will be awarded at 50% for 2020/21 finalists and 20% for 2019/20 and 2018/19 finalists.
- If a sponsorship agreement is sought for payment of fees at any point during the programme the benefit will cease.



Fee discount conditions continued:

- Students must have responsibility for payment of their own tuition fee (ie no sponsor or external bursary) (Receipt of a postgraduate loan via the Postgraduate Master's Loan Scheme will still entitle you to this benefit);
- Students must be enrolled onto an Edge Hill University Postgraduate Certificate, Diploma, Masters or Research programme** either full or part-time, commencing in 2021/22;
- Students must be studying a minimum of 60 credits each academic year (with the exception of PGCert SpLD Dyslexia);
- To be eligible, students must have no outstanding debt with the University.

** Excludes PGCE, Integrated Masters, MSc Midwifery, MSc Nursing, MSc Advanced Fertility Practice, MSc Clinical Reproductive Medicine, Professional Doctorate, PG Cert Medical Leadership and MCh/MMed programmes.


How to apply:

There is no application process. You will be invited to confirm your eligibility during enrolment. Once verified, your tuition fee and payment plan will be adjusted.
