Re: Mywellness Cloud GDPR compliance

Technogym Mywellness Cloud systems comply with the data protection directives and laws currently in force in the EU as per the attached Data Processing Agreement, which any customer of the Mywellness Cloud platform may adopt by sending a request to the Technogym team.

Referencing to the GDPR entry into force scheduled on May 25, 2018, we are implementing a compliance plan, which includes the following:

- a gap analysis between the existing situation and the GDPR requirements;
- the review of all current data protection documentation (privacy policies, data processing agreements, etc.) and adapt them as per the GDPR requirements;
- the implementation of new SOPs to comply with the privacy by design and privacy by default controls;
- the conduct of a Privacy Impact Assessment if and where required by the law;
- the appointment of a Data Protection Officer.

Concerning the above, please note that as many of the factual directions deriving from the GDPR adoption are still to be released or have been adopted very recently by the governing authorities, compliance with the GDPR is obviously still on progress.

Nonetheless, we are committed to be compliant with the applicable rules in the GDPR by delivering the corresponding new version of the Mywellness® Cloud Data Processing Agreement by March 2018.
